Safety is of paramount importance to us. All our instructors have completed Tusla's Children First programme. All our instructors are qualified in Outdoor First Aid Remote Emergency Care Level 3. CCTV is present throughout the common areas of the hostel building and many other public areas. From 9.30pm to 9.30am night guard supervision is present in the hostel, along with support of a night porter in the hotel. During mealtimes we provide supervision where food is served and additionally in the hostel building. We follow strict safety procedures following national governing bodies and equipment supplier ratios and operating standards. Two teachers or group leaders must be present on-site at all times and in a position to assist our team if a child in their group requires support for any reason (unruly behaviour, child safety issues, etc) or in the event they will need to act as loco parentis for a medical emergency.
